



## INSTRUCTIONS



Materials needed: Wire Ties (provided)  
Wire Cutters

Estimated Install time: 30 minutes

1. Start by opening your hood and propping your hood up.
2. You need to gain access to behind the grill.
3. Along the top of the grill area there are some push clips that hold the top of the grill on. Loosen and remove the needed push clips and gently pull the grill shell outward.
4. Place the mesh grill on top of the existing grill.
5. Starting on one top corner, run a cable tie tail from the back of the existing grill and also through the mesh grill.
6. Push the cable tie tail through an adjacent diamond (above or below) so that the cable tie will secure around one mesh diamond and on one stock grill bar.
7. Fasten the cable tie securely.
8. Repeat for the other side, and then apply some to the bottom and the center areas.
9. Trim the cable tie ends.
10. Push the grill back in place and replace the push clips.
