INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

What's in the Box: (2 or 4) Grill Mesh Pieces, (8) Ties, (1) Small Spool of Wire.

Tool List: Needle Nose Pliers, Wire Cutters, Adhesive (for lower mesh installation).

Top Mesh Installation:

- 1. To remove the stock inserts you need to pull them out from the front. Typically this can be started by pulling the bottom portion of the insert up and out. Needle Nose Pliers can help in grabbing onto the honeycomb stock grill.
- 2. Then work your way around grill, pulling each area towards the center of the grill and then out. If you look closely, you can see all the area where the grill snaps in. Once both are out, open the hood.
- 3. Loosen the top splash guard from the top of the grill area by releasing the fastening mechanisms.
- 4. Place the one of the inserts on the stock grill opening.
- 5. Have someone hold the grill in. Run a tie through a stock grill installation point (starting them from behind the stock grill). Then loop the cable tie back through an adjacent mesh diamond. Check to make sure the cable tie is going around one of the existing grill installation tab openings
- 6. Secure the cable tie and repeat this process a few more times so that the grill is secured.
- 7. Repeat step 4, 5, & 6 for the other section.
- 8. Clip the ends of the cable ties off. Replace and secure the top splash guard, and close your hood.

Bottom Mesh Installation:

The bottom pieces install from behind the opening but they need to be carefully fed in from the front at an angle. The 90 degree bent flap on the grills will go above the painted part of the bumper. The bottom pieces will temporarily hold in place well, but you'll need to use an adhesive where the mesh and the bumper meet to safely secure them to the vehicle.
