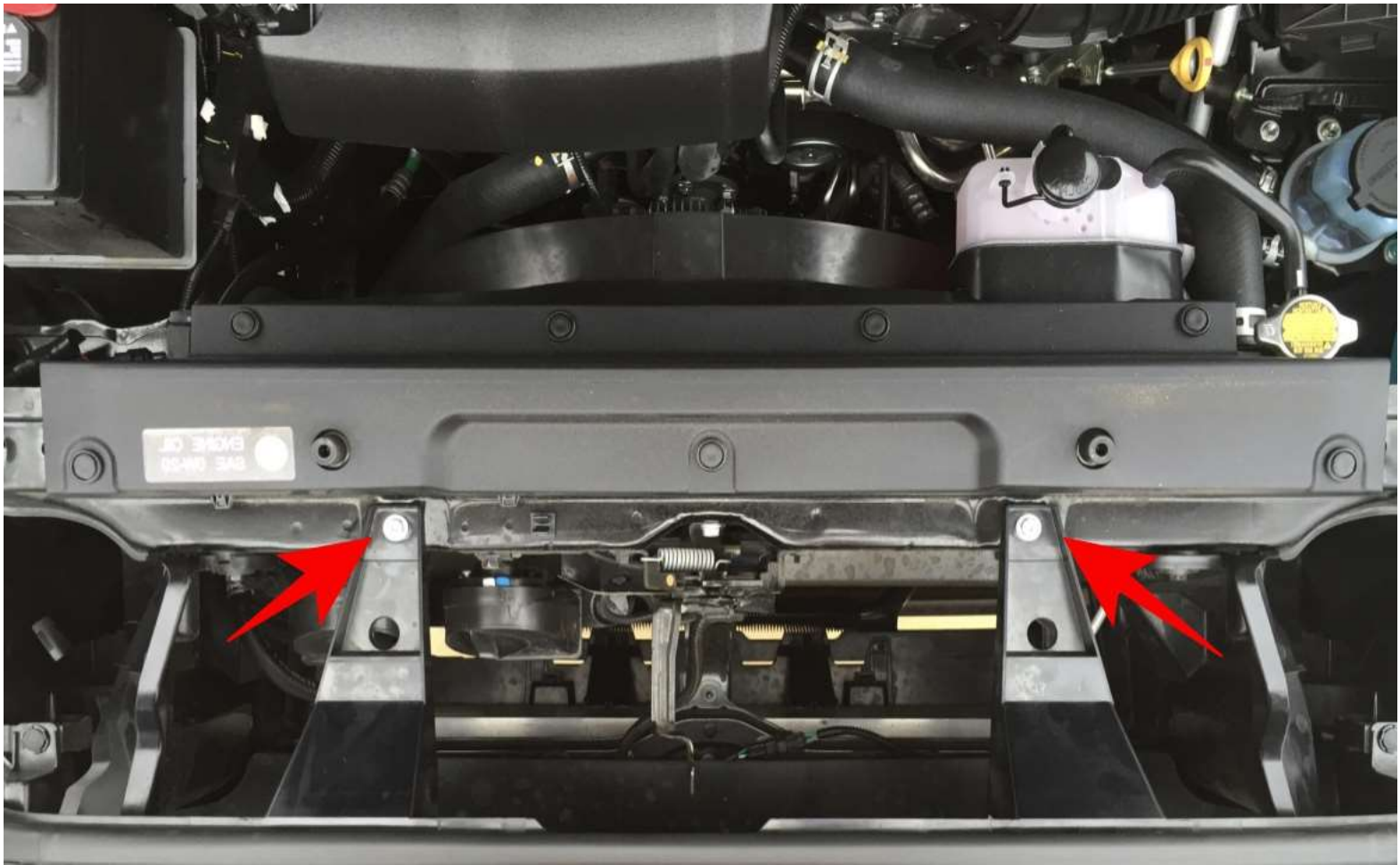


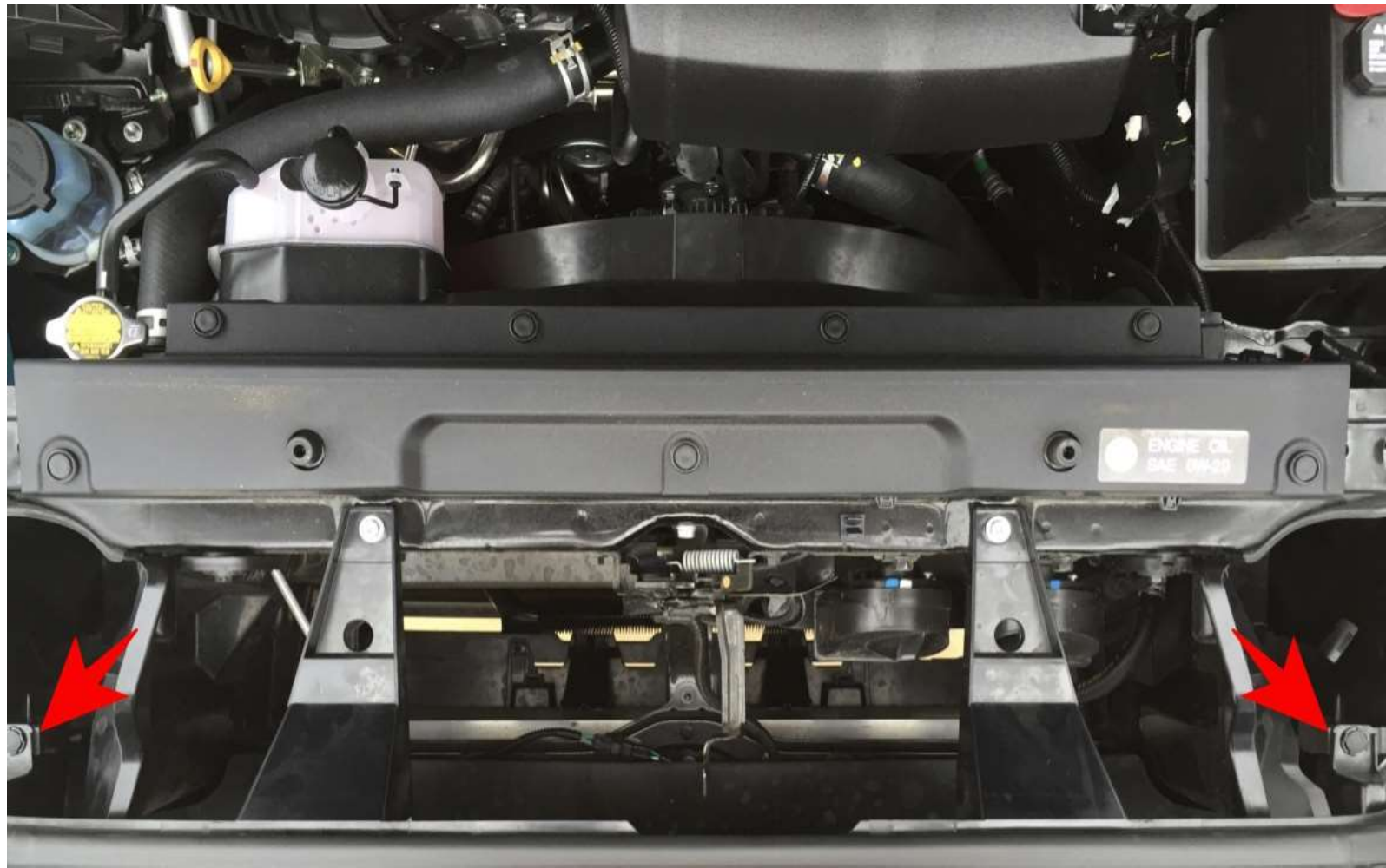
2016+ Toyota Tacoma Grill Assembly Removal

Begin with removing the two bolts (shown below by the red arrows) with a 10mm socket. Set the two bolts aside.



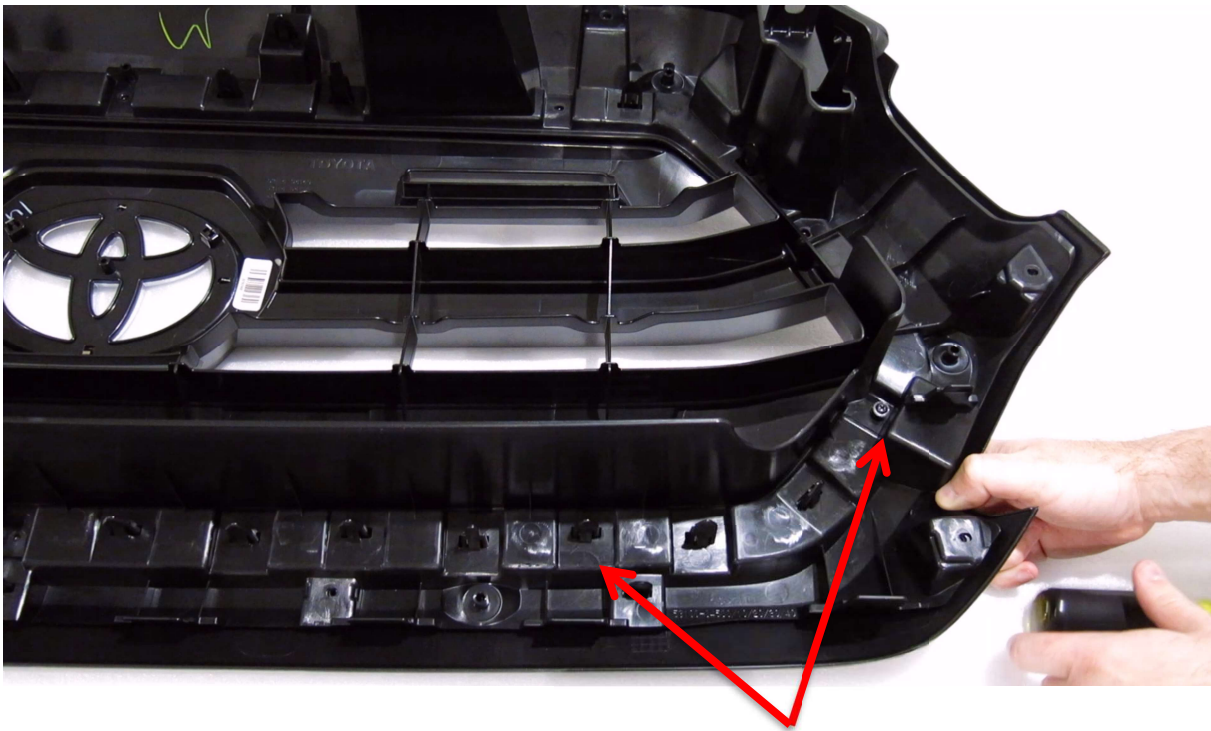
Next, use a small flathead screwdriver to pop up the pins on the retainer clips, shown below. These are just inside the light

housings, behind the grill. Once pins are popped up, remove them and set aside.



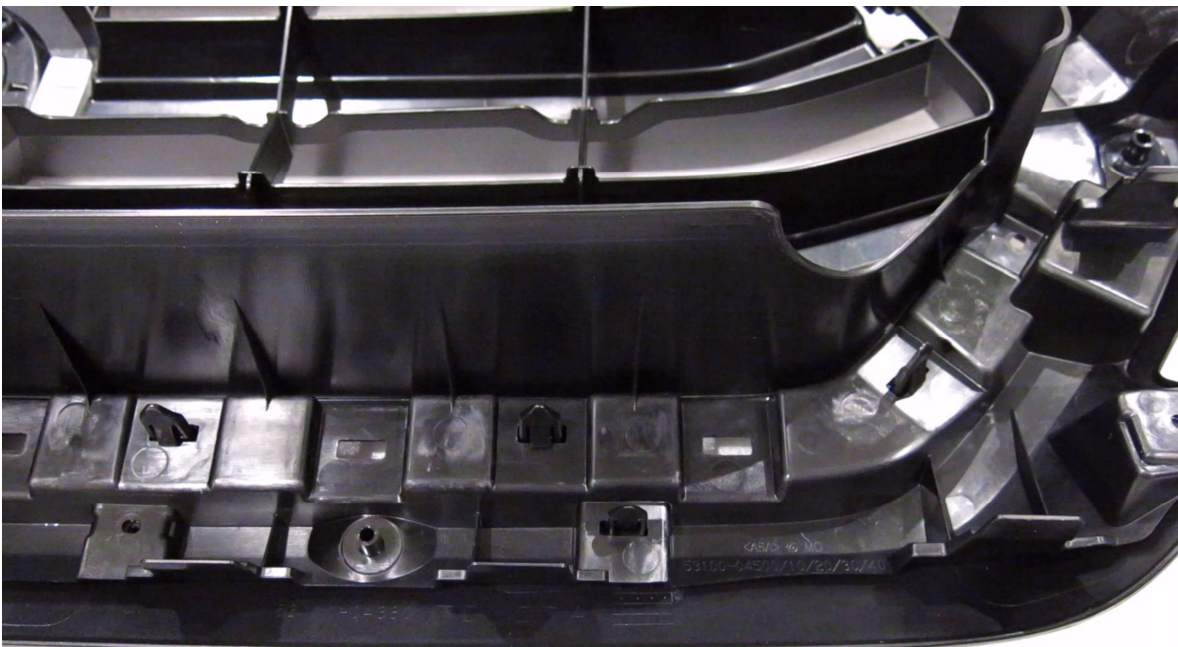
Once the fasteners are removed, set them aside. A slight tug forward (away from the truck) on the bottom and top of the central grill assembly, it will come off. Be careful not to drop it!





On the back of the grille, remove the small Phillips head screws that are holding the bezel in place.

Then release the tabs that are holding the bezel in place.



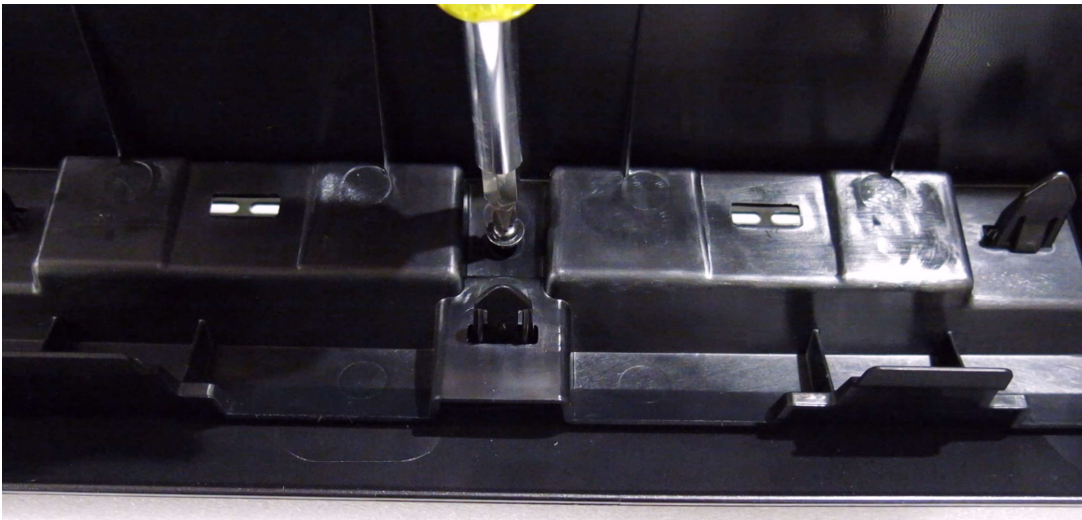
The remaining tabs that hold the inner grille portion can now be released.



The grill shell should be hollow now and ready for the new grille to be inserted.



Line the tabs of the new grille up and press it in place until the tabs click.



Re-install the bezel screws that were removed in an earlier step.



The last step is to install the grille assembly back on the truck.

Re-installation is the reverse of removal.
